

**Date** 25 May 2014. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track).

**Habitat:** Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

**Substrate:** Dead *Clematis aristata*.

**Description:** Crowded sessile sporangia, globose to short plasmodiocarps. Globose sporangia 0.6–0.9 mm diameter; plasmodiocarps 1.5 mm x 0.7 mm diameter. **Hypothallus** shiny, reddish brown. **Peridium** membranous, fragile, iridescent with mainly purple reflections; white with thin layer of lime when first collected, some veins of white persist. **Columella** absent. **Capillitium** network of white limy tubules. **Spores** globose to sub-globose, dark brown in mass, brown by transmitted light, minutely warted, 11–12  $\mu\text{m}$ .

**Notes:** Several collections found on dead *Clematis aristata*.
